Study Options

PRIVATE LESSONS: The one-on-one contact between teacher and student in the traditional private lesson, allows the instruction to be catered to the student's unique needs. This is the best choice for motivated students at any level of experience. Private lessons are scheduled once each week for thirty minutes. (\$360 per trimester)

PAIR LESSONS: Two students and a teacher meet for thirty minutes once each week in pair lessons. This arrangement offers the flexibility of allocating part of the lesson to each student, working with both students together, and having the students coach each other under the direct supervision of a teacher. The social aspect of pair lessons is motivating to many students. (\$250 for each student per trimester)

CLASS LESSONS: Small groups of students work with the teacher and each other in group lessons. The teacher sets the pace for each student. Older, more advanced students build their mastery by coaching younger, less experienced students. This provides an ideal, introductory experience for many students. (\$150 per trimester)

Visual Art

Digital Photography Basics: Compose. Expose. Communicate. This class is an introduction to the fundamentals of digital photography. We'll explore how the visual aspects of composition, lighting, exposure, aperture, shutter speed and subject matter come together to create meaningful and lasting images. Finally, we will learn some important processing tips and tricks using Photoshop. Students will need to supply their own digital camera for each class. Taught by professional photographer, Robert Rostick. Grades 5 - 8.

Mixed Media Sculpture- This unique mixed media art class is designed for 5th through 8th grade students who enjoy working with tactile materials. An emphasis will be placed on learning a variety of sculptural concepts and techniques including clay modeling, papier-mâché, wire sculpture and use of found objects. This class is limited to six students.

Masters in Fine Arts- this hands-on journey for children ages 3-8 introduces students to the Masters of the periods in art. Children will learn about each artist's unique contributions to the world of art and will discover what inspired each Master through drawing, painting, sculpture, and building... The curriculum is year long, and broken into 3 trimester classes (\$150 each), which culminate with a May art show! Taught by professional art director Jill Campisciano. Students will need:

1. A 1-1/2 in., 3 ring binder to hold Masters' biography sheets.
2. A new, white t-shirt- due by the first class in February for May paint project

Musical Theatre

Into The Woods- This musical intertwines the plots of several Brothers Grimm fairy tales and follows them further to explore the consequences of the characters' wishes and quests. The main characters are taken from the stories of *Little Red Riding Hood*, *Jack and the Beanstalk*, *Rapunzel*, and *Cinderella*, tied together by a more original story involving a baker and his wife and their quest to begin a family.

Tuition cost is \$75 and covers November 13, 2010 – March 12, 2011. Each family is required to sell or buy 20 tickets, at \$10 per ticket. These can be used at any of the six performances and will enable many people to enjoy the performance of our talented students and exciting show. There will be two different age groups performing this show encompassing students from 3rd-12th Grade. The exact breakdown will be determined once all students have enrolled, but roughly 3rd-8th Grade and 9th-12th Grade.

Directed by Seth Travaglino. Rehearsals will take place on Saturday mornings at IDS-CC from 9:00AM – 1:00PM.

Auditions will be held on Saturday, November 13th, 9:00AM-1:00PM. Please be prepared for the following:

- 16-32 bars of a song that shows your vocal range. Have sheet music or a CD with or without vocals to accompany the performance.
- A cold reading from *Into The Woods*

Rehearsals will begin on Saturday, December 4th, 9:00AM-1:00PM.

Performances are scheduled for Thursday, March 10-Sunday, March 13, 2011
