With a book by Rupert Holmes and music & lyrics by John Kander and Fred Ebb, the same team that penned "Cabaret" & "Chicago," the show is based on the original book and concept by Peter Stone, a musical with backstage murder mystery plots. The show is directed by Seth Travaglino.

Set in 1959 Boston, Massachusetts, the show follows the fallout when the supremely untalented star of 'Robbin' Hood of the Old West is murdered during her opening night curtain call.
