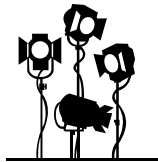

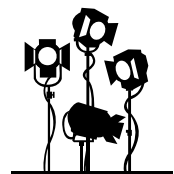

Since our last Heads' Letter we celebrated **GrandParents and GrandFriends Day**. It was a day of smiles and joy. Here are some of the highlights:

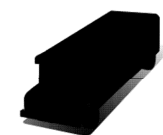
1. Because we started a half hour earlier this year, the increased time allowed for increased ease in enjoying both the program performances and visits to the classroom.

**REMINDER: THE SECOND OFFERING OF THE LUNCH PROGRAM
STARTS TUESDAY, JANUARY 3, 2012**

This year's lunch program has exceeded all of our expectations. The students have been enjoying tasty and nutritious lunches everyday. The IDS Catering Team would like to thank everyone; especially the volunteers who have helped make our lunch program such a "delicious" success!

For our second offering, we have some wonderful entrees; homemade lasagna, grilled chicken wraps, beef soft tacos, spaghetti and meatballs, and grilled cheese and tomato bisque, just to name a few. All food is prepared fresh daily by our kitchen professionals.

The IDS Lunch Program will include a choice of: **1.) Meal, 2.) Salad or a 3.) Bag Lunch.** As you review the second offering for this school year, you will find a wide variety of healthy kid-friendly food choices. We also include fresh cut seasonal fruit, garden fresh veggies, and a beverage with every meal. Attached you will find our menu for January thru June.

Our second lunch offering will begin Tuesday, January 3, 2012. It is very important that families who wish to participate in the lunch program the first week of school return the lunch order form to the IDS Office by **Thursday December 15, 2011.**

Please enclose a check with your child's order form and return it to the IDS business office. **Walk-ups** will be charged monthly for the bag lunches. Please note that there are no refunds or lunch exchanges due to student absences or field trips.

The IDS Lunch Program has many purchase plans available – all purchase plans include a beverage - water, fruit juice, or milk.

Option #1 – Win Win Plan; If you have already signed up for the Win Win Plan please fill out the lunch form to verify if your child would like a meal or salad for each day.

Option #2 – Full Purchase Plan; this plan will provide your child with lunch for the entire second offering (January 3rd thru June 1st). Please select a meal or salad on the attached order form. The cost of this plan is **\$4.00 a lunch**. Your total cost will be **(\$4.00 x 92 days) \$368.00** for the second session.

Option #3 – Partial Purchase Plan; this plan will allow you to pick and choose from the attached order form. Please select a meal or salad for days you would like to purchase lunch. The price of this plan is **\$5.00 a lunch**.

Option #4 – Walk Up Charges; this is for students needing a lunch. These students will be provided with a bag lunch which includes their choice of a fresh turkey and cheese **or** peanut butter and jelly sandwich, chips, granola bar, fresh fruit, and a beverage. All walk up lunches will be charged **\$6.00** or you can pay cash at the time of purchase. If there is enough of the meal of the day, that is a possible choice depending only on the amount of food remaining.


Option #5 - Drink Options; students bringing a lunch from home or someone who has purchased a lunch may buy a beverage for **\$1.00**.

If you purchase the **Win Win** or **Full Purchase Plans**, your child has the option of substituting a bag lunch for a hot meal at the time of service. Students will make their beverage selection at lunch time. Daily beverage choices consist of one (1) of the following per lunch:

- Milk (1% or chocolate) or
- Bottled water or
- 100% fruit juice

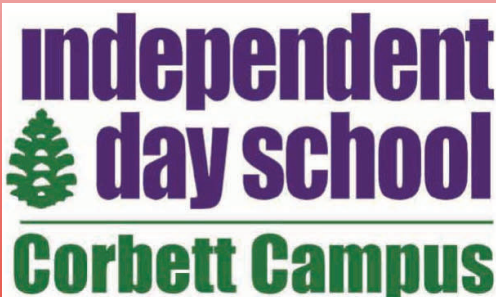
